**PROJECT BACKGROUND**

The 1,000,000 square foot food processing plant, initially constructed in the late 1800's, was expanded over the years through numerous additions. An elevated commuter train ran through the complex below a 2-story bridge which connected the separate structures. Asbestos abatement was required for friable asbestos on the structural steel bridge members. Brandenburg removed the bridge and adjacent structures without any interruptions to the commuter trains.

**SCOPE OF WORK**

Engineer custom debris protection for elevated train structure

Design asbestos abatement plan for entire facility and connecting bridge

Remove all asbestos in facility

Remove underground storage tanks

Recycle mercury containing lamps

Remove and dispose of all PCB containing equipment

Manage process water discharge in accordance with NPDES permit and local water reclamation district

Remove 2-story connecting bridge structure over operating commuter tracks

Demolish 7-story structure adjacent to an elevated commuter train line
