PROJECT BACKGROUND

SCOPE OF WORK

Engineer a detailed specification including all utility, environmental, and dismantling work to be performed

Develop and maintain a site specific Health & Safety Program as well as site security

Remove Units 15, 16, and 17 consisting of four coal fired boilers, three turbine generators, and all associated equipment

Remove a coal preparation plant

Remove an office and service building

Remove a water treatment plant and a sewage treatment plant

Recover and dismantle a submerged barge

Remove other miscellaneous structures and perform site work

Prepare all necessary permits

Perform all required utility disconnections

Remove, segregate, package, load, and dispose of all waste streams

Remove and market all salvageable equipment

Purchase, segregate, prepare, and market all scrap metals
